The Paula S. Cousins Ovarian & Endometrial Cancer Foundation is now accepting applications for their 2026 scholarships. Two scholarships will be offered, valued at \$1000 each. To qualify, graduating seniors must attend high school in Crawford, Erie or Warren County, PA, and must have felt the effects of cancer in their life, whether personally or through their sibling, or parents/legal guardian. The type of cancer affecting the applicant is not limited to Ovarian or Endometrial Cancer.

The Paula's Promise Scholarship Committee will review all applications and determine the winner. The essay should describe how cancer has affected your life. It should also include the type of cancer, when the cancer occurred, and who has/had cancer. Community service, extracurricular activity involvement, and academic achievement may be considered. Please see the third page for the list of items that must be included with your application. **ANY MISSING DOCUMENTS WILL VOID YOUR APPLICATION.**

- Applicants must be graduating high school seniors from any Crawford, Erie or Warren County PA school districts who have been affected by cancer, either by being diagnosed themselves or due to a sibling, or parent/guardian being diagnosed.
- Applicants must have been accepted at an accredited university, college, or vocational school.
- Application, Letter of Acceptance, high school transcript, essay, photograph, two references, and an overview of extracurricular and/or community involvement must be compiled and received or postmarked by APRIL 1, 2026.
- Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the college listed on your application.
- Any change in college, university, or vocational school or delay starting could nullify the scholarship.
- **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED OR POSTMARKED BY APRIL 1, 2026**

All application materials are considered confidential, will be limited to examination for the intended purposes only, and become property of the Foundation. All personal materials, excluding essays and photographs of the applicants awarded the scholarships, will be destroyed following the selection of the winners. Please note that the photograph provided will not be returned.

Completed applications must be received or postmarked by April 1, 2026.
